Advice for playing Medical Dominoes

- This activity is best done with one set of cards between 3 to 5 students.
- Prepare for the activity by familiarizing students with the vocabulary (below).
- When you're ready to play, lay all the cards face up on a large table or desk.
- Choose a card at random, then try to match another card to the part of the word on the first card (for example, match 'hypo-' to '-tension').
- Keep building a chain of cards, working from both ends of the chain.
- Be careful! Some endings on the cards are very similar (-ology / -logy)
- Encourage students to make one long chain, not several small chains.
